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



#### AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned incorporators, hereby associate ourselves together and make, subscribe, and acknowledge this Amended Certificate of Incorporation.

# ARTICLE 1. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Charlotte County Fair Association, Inc. and its principal office is located at 1193 Enterprise Dr. A-6, Port Charlotte, Florida. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office to any other address in Charlotte County.

#### ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

The general nature of this corporation's objects and power shall be:

- (a) The sole purpose of this incorporation is to conduct and operate public fairs or expositions for the benefit and development of the educational, agricultural, horticultural, livestock and other resources of the state or any county or counties of the state.
- (b) It is intended that this corporation qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or any corresponding Section of any future federal tax code.

- (c) To buy, lease, acquire and occupy lands and to erect buildings and improvements of all kinds thereon and to develop same and to sell, mortgage, lease or convey said property or any part thereof, in its discretion from time to time, and to sell or rent spaces for exhibitions or other privileges.
- (d) To hold, conduct and maintain Midways, also to conduct and operate public fairs for handicraft and educational projects.
- (e) To charge and receive reasonable compensation for admissions to such fairs or expositions.
- (f) To conduct and hold public meetings, to supervise and conduct lectures and all kinds of demonstration work in connection with, or for the improvement of, home demonstration, agricultural or horticultural work and matters connected therewith.
- (g) To hold exhibits of home demonstrations, agricultural and horticultural products and to give certificates of diplomas of excellence.
- (h) To do, perform and carry out all matters, acts and business, usual or proper in connection with fairs and expositions as defined in Chapter 616 of the Florida Statutes.
- (i) To do any and all things permitted corporations not for profit and permitted to be done under the laws of the State of Florida.
- (j) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the

corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein.

- (k) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- (1) Any other provisions of these articles not withstanding, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on 1) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or 2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

There shall be three (3) classifications of membership; regular membership, ex-officio membership and honorary membership.

Regular membership shall be construed as being those individuals who are the original charter members, then any other members so elected and added as additions or replacements. Subsequent to the original charter membership, applicants for regular membership shall be decided by the vote of the majority of the regular and ex-officio members present at a publicized

meeting for such purpose. To be eligible for regular membership an individual must be a resident of Charlotte County, a qualified elector of the County, and must have demonstrated genuine interest in service to his community and the county.

An agent of Charlotte County shall be a permanent regular member of this Fair Association.

Ex-Officio membership shall be membership extended to the President of the Charlotte Jaycees, the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Charlotte Jaycees, and any Jaycee International Senators who express a desire to continue membership in such Association.

Honorary membership shall be construed to include those individuals in the community appointed by the President of this Association whose leadership and particular vocations would enable them to render valuable advice and direction to the Association. Such honorary members shall be an advisory board and shall not be vested with voting power in managing the affairs of the Association. Such individuals would include but not be limited to the following:

The Superintendent of Public Instruction for the County, the President of the Chamber of Commerce, Assistant County Agents and Agricultural Extension Agents, the local Legislators, the Mayor of the City of Punta Gorda, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners.

The terms of the regular members shall be three (3) years. Termination of membership in all categories shall be automatic upon resignation, expulsion for good cause (which shall be by a majority of the members of said Association at a meeting specifically called for such business, providing the member to be expelled has been notified by registered mail at least twenty (20) days in advance of such contemplated action), or the termination of the office under which a member is granted ex-officio or honorary membership into said Association.

#### ARTICLE IV. DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE V. SUBSCRIBERS

#### ARTICLE VI. OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a President, as many Vice-Presidents as are needed for proper implementation of the corporation, a Treasurer, a Secretary, a Board of Directors of not less than twenty nor more than fifty members, and by such other officers and agents as may be elected or appointed from time to time. The annual meeting of the members of this corporation shall be held within the boundaries of Charlotte County, Florida, on the first Monday after the first Thursday in July, beginning in July, A.D. 1989. The members shall elect an Executive Board of Directors at each annual

meeting to hold office for the ensuing year, and the Executive Board of Directors as elected shall hold a meeting as soon thereafter as possible and shall elect at such meeting the officers of this corporation who shall hold office for the ensuing year. The Executive Board of Directors shall have the power to appoint an executive committee, which shall have all the powers usual to such committees. All officers shall continue in office until their successors have been elected and have assumed office. In case any office of this corporation becomes vacant, the Executive Board of Directors shall fill such vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term.

# ARTICLE VII. MANAGEMENT OF AFFAIRS

The affairs of the corporation shall be directed by the president, first vice president, second vice president, secretary and treasurer pursuant to these articles and the duly adopted bylaws.

## ARTICLE VIII. BYLAWS

The bylaws of this corporation will be enacted by the first Executive Board of Directors elected and thereafter the bylaws shall be altered or rescinded only by a 2/3 vote of the registered voting members at the time of the vote.

### ARTICLE IX. DEBT

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which this corporation may at any time subject itself is \$10,000,000.00.

#### ARTICLE X. DISSOLUTION

Unless otherwise provided in state statute, upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed to one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or a corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose, and any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation has been located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Florida Statute provides that upon the dissolution of the corporation all money and property of such association shall, except for the payment of its just debts and liabilities, be and remain perpetually public property. Any public funds or property remaining in the Association when the said corporation is dissolved shall be distributed by resolution of the Board of Directors and upon order of the Circuit Judge to any county, or city within the county, and may provide in the distribution resolution the public project for which the funds shall be used or the use to which the property shall be put provided, however, that where property has been contributed by a city or county that property shall be reconveyed to the city or county making the contribution of said property.
