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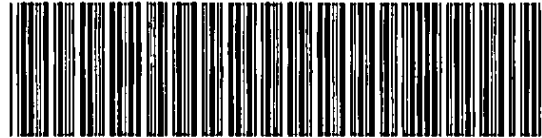

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Attachment to the Articles of Incorporation

City Central Church, Inc.

Article III:

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- A. The Corporation is organized exclusively for the purposes set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) (the "Code"). The purposes of the Corporation shall include: operating a Christian church.
- B. To conduct any and all activities and exercise any and all powers as may be necessary or helpful to the achievement of the foregoing purposes for which the Corporation is organized.
- C. The Corporation is intended to be an organization which is exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. All terms and provisions of these Articles of Incorporation shall be construed, applied and carried out in accordance with such intent. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II.A. hereof. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- D. The Corporation shall not directly or indirectly participate or intervene in any political campaign including, but not limited to, the publishing or distribution of statements on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or any corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).
- E. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed to another church, or for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as such court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
