The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Non-Profit Corporation pursuant to s. 617.0202, F.S. hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

**ARTICLE I**

**NAME**

The name of the corporation shall be: The Orlando Alumni Kappa Foundation, Incorporated.

**ARTICLE II**

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**PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS**

The principal place of business is: 832 Courtland Street, Orlando, FL 32804 and the mailing address of this corporation is P.O. Box 555088, Orlando, Florida, 32855-5088.

**ARTICLE III**

**PURPOSE**

**Section 1.** The specific purpose of the Orlando Alumni Kappa Foundation, Incorporated is to perform community service which include fund raising, social action and mentoring programs (educational, scientific, literary) that will inspire youth to achieve in college and adult life.

**Section 2.** The general purpose for which this Non-Profit foundation is organized is exclusively charitable and within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Service Code. The foundation awards scholarships, participate in after school programs, Orange County Community Centers including Head Start and Senior Citizens programs. The Foundation and its independent Board of Directors and volunteers will solicit donations from locations in Florida and people in Florida and will comply with the requirements of Chapter 496, F.S., the Solicitation and Contribution Act.

**ARTICLE IV**

**MANNER IN WHICH THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS ARE ELECTED**

**Section 1.** The initial members of the Board of Directors shall be appointed by the Executive Board and approved by the general membership of the Orlando Alumni Chapter (OAC) of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated. Subsequent elections shall be held as provided for in the Orlando Alumni Kappa Foundation, Incorporated Bylaws. The Orlando Alumni Kappa Foundation, Incorporated Officers/Directors will serve for a period of one (1) and two (2) years depending on the position. The Board of Directors and officers shall be elected in November and, installed in December as stated by the Orlando Alumni Kappa Foundation, Incorporated Bylaws.

**Section 2.** The number of board members, officers and committees may increase as the corporation experiences growth, as provided for in the Orlando Alumni Kappa Foundation, Incorporated Bylaws.

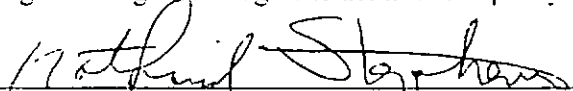
**DISSOLUTION CLAUSE**

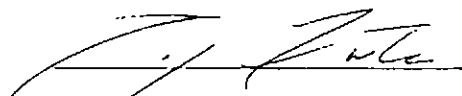

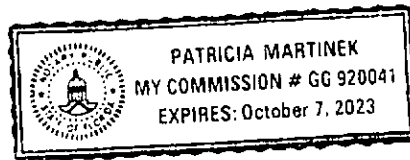
