ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF LUKUMI CULTURAL ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation not-for-profit pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, Chapter 617.0202 F.S., hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

Lukumi Cultural Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for religious, cultural, educational and charitable purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

- 1. The primary purpose of this organization is to preserve the Lukumi culture. Provide a temple to conduct religious services, and a facility for educational and social events in accordance with the practice of the Lukumi faith.
- 2. To establish and conduct family counseling and or drug preventive program on behalf of its members and all other individuals in need.
- 3. To provide a facility to exhibit attributes of the Lukumi religion.
- 4. To solicit funds and donations from time to time to further the purposes of this corporation.
- 5. To acquire and receive by purchase, donation or otherwise, any property, real, personal or mixed, and to hold, use and dispose of the same.

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- 6. To borrow money and to issue evidence of indebtedness in furtherance of any or all of the objects of its business, and to secure loans by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or other liens.
- 7. To apply for, obtain and contract with any federal, state, or local government or agency for a direct loan or other financial aid in the form of grants or otherwise relating to the purposes of this corporation.
- 8. To engage in any kind of activity, and to enter into, perform and carry out contracts of any kind, necessary or in connection with, or incidental to the accomplishment of any one or more of the non-profit purposes of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV - Terms of Existence

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual, unless sooner dissolved in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. The date on which corporate existence shall begin is:

ARTICLE V - Manner of Election

ARTICLE VIII - Corporation Amendment

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These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at a special meeting of the Board of Directors called for that purpose by a three-fourth (3/4) vote of those present, but it must have the approval of the President of Lukumi Cultural Association, Inc.

ARTICLE VIX – Earnings

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure the benefit of any individual or member.

ARTICLE X - Membership

The membership of this corporation shall be constituted of all persons named as subscribers and such other persons as from time to time may become members in the manner provided in the by-laws.

ARTICLE XI - Provision

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTCLE XII - Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
