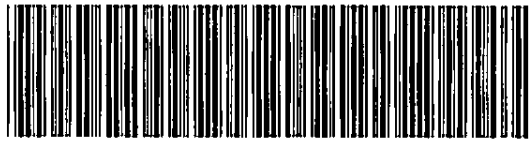

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S. (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be LBV Touchdown Club, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose of LBV Touchdown Club, Inc. is to support the student athletes, parents, and coaches of the LBV Football Team by recruiting volunteers, raising funds, and conducting events in support of the football Teams at Lake Buena Vista High School in Orlando, Florida, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. The donations and contributions received by LBV Touchdown Club, Inc. may be used to provide the football student athletes with new and updated equipment and uniforms, required facility fees and field maintenance, transportation and meal needs, referees, tournament fees, banquets, player awards, and/or other needs determined appropriate by the Booster Club. The LBV Touchdown Club, Inc. will perform fundraisers such as the Vertical Raise fundraiser, assist with sponsorship donations, as well as multiple other and various fundraisers throughout the year to benefit the football teams.

The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. (All references to sections in these Articles refer to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended or to comparable sections of subsequent internal revenue laws.) In pursuance of these purposes, it shall do all things necessary, proper, and consistent with maintaining tax exempt status under section 501 (c)(3).

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which directors are elected and appointed is as provided in the Bylaws.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any director, employee or other individual, partnership, estate, trust or corporation having a personal or private interest in the corporation. Compensation for services actually rendered and reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in attending to the affairs of this corporation shall be limited to reasonable amounts. No substantial amount of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propoganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and this corporation shall not intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles or of any Bylaws adopted thereunder, this corporation shall not take any action not permitted by the laws which then apply to this corporation.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, its assets shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or distributed to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes which shall, at the time, qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

Having been named as registered agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity.
