## Addendum to Article 3

The corporation does indemnify any directors, officers, employees, incorporators, and members of the corporation from any liability regarding the corporation and the affairs of the corporation, unless the person fraudulently and intentionally violated the laws and/or maliciously conducted acts to damage and/or defraud the corporation, or as otherwise provided under applicable statue.

The purpose of the corporation is exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code and herein stated as follows:

The purpose for which the corporation is to actively solicit and collect children's costumes (new and used). Ella's Costume Closet will host collection drives in neighborhoods and at schools with the help of volunteers in the community. Costumes will be cleaned, sorted, and stored -and then distributed for free to children, families, and schools who need them. The non-profit will solicit in-kind donations of costumes and fundraise to cover the costs of cleaning and storage. Costumes will be distributed on an annual basis for holidays and to schools for "page".

The character and essence of the corporation is the same as the purpose.

No parts of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or benefit distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 11. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in the opposition of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercises any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the legal liabilities of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such.
