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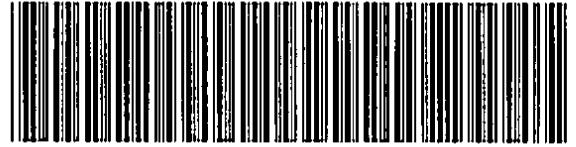



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
WEPAH FOUNDATION, INC.

The undersigned incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract in the State of Florida, hereby presents these Articles of Incorporation for the formation of a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is **WEPAH FOUNDATION, INC.**

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

The address of the principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is:

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ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The corporation's purpose is to educate children and young adults in communities in need with the fundamentals of skills and trades that they can utilize in their lives. The corporation is organized and operates exclusively for such lawful, charitable, educational and literary purposes, as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The purposes of the corporation also include the performance of activities related to or incidental to the furtherance of the corporation's stated purposes and permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed is determined by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V – BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The corporation shall have initially four (4) Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall consist of such number of persons as fixed pursuant to the Bylaws of the corporation from time to time, but shall not be less than the minimum number prescribed by the applicable Florida law. The qualifications to serve as a director, the rights and powers of the directors, and the method of appointment or election of directors shall be specified in the Bylaws of the corporation. The Bylaws of this corporation shall be made, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XI - EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date for these Articles of Incorporation is June 13, 2022.
