### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CHRIÓ MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL INC.

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Law of the State of Florida, do herby certify.

#### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: CHRIÓ MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL INC.

#### ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation will be located is the City of Tampa at the following address:

10416 Glenn Willow Lane, Tampa, Florida, 33647.

#### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, which include:

- (A) To disseminate the Gospel of The Kingdom of God as taught by Jesus Christ with the hope that all who hear it will come to the saving knowledge of Christ and make Him Lord their lives.
- B) To disseminate the Word of God, resulting in God's people becoming conformed the the image of Jesus Christ.
- (C) To birth Christian Churches around the world.
- (D)To raise and train Christian leaders around the world.
- (E) To work with Churches to build, grow and expand their ministries.
- (F) To provide training materials for discipleship to churches and other religious groups.
- (G) To host Christian conferences.
- (H) To provide financial aid and support to charitable organizations.
- (I) To sell Christian books, training manuals, and other Christian material in all forms and formats.
- (J) To conduct Christian training seminars to release Christians in the ministry to which they are called.

- (K) To implement programs and build/rent facilities that will help people with drug addictions, alcohol addictions, and other addictive behaviors overcome these strongholds in their lives.
- (K) To implement programs and build/rent facilities that will help people who are homeless find temporary shelter as well as get assistance until they can return to normal life.
- (L) To aid the poor in the form of clothing, food, temporary shelter, skills training, and job placement

#### ARTICLE IV - MANNER OF ELECTION

The Manner in which Directors will be appointed and elected will be as follows:

The initially appointed Directors are the only persons with the power to appoint new Directors and along with any subsequently appointed Directors are the only persons with the power to remove an existing Director from that position.

If the existing Directors would like to appoint another Director they shall call a special meeting of the Board of Directors to which the potential candidate will be invited.

One of the Directors shall make a motion that this candidate be considered for appointment Board of Directors. Another member of the Board of Directors shall second the motion and then it shall be put to a vote.

Only when all members of the Board of Directors vote yes shall the candidate be confirmed and formally appointed as a member of the Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE V -- EARNINGS OF THE CORPORATION

How earnings will be used:

The income and property of this corporation however derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the corporation as outlined in Section III of this Article of Association. No portion thereof including its net profit shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividends, or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to the Directors of the corporation.

The corporation shall in good faith make payments of reasonable and proper remuneration to any Director, officer or servant of the corporation, in return for any services rendered either as a paid full-time employee, a paid part-time employee, or a volunteer of the corporation.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

#### ARTICLE VI – POWERS OF THE CORPORATION

The Corporation shall have the following powers which shall be exercised in the furtherance of the objects of the Corporation namely:

- (A) To obtain funding and financing from individuals, agencies, organizations, firms, and other entities.
- (B) To advance or lend money upon such security as may be thought proper, or without taking any security as collateral.
- (C) To purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire, or by device, legacy, gift or otherwise to acquire real or personal property and any rights or privileges necessary or convenient for the Corporation.
- (D) To sell, lease, exchange, dispose of, develop, and turn to account, or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property and rights for the time being of the Corporation for such consideration in money or otherwise and upon such terms as the Corporation shall deem expedient with a view to the promotion of its objects.
- (E) To borrow or raise money for any of the purposes of the Corporation on such terms as may seem expedient and for payment thereof or the satisfaction of any obligation or liabilities of the Corporation in such manner as the Corporation shall think fit, and in particular by mortgage charge or lien upon any part of the Corporation's property whether present or future or by the issue of debenture stock perpetual or redeemable charged upon all or any part of such terms and conditions in all respects as may seem expedient and also by similar mortgage charge or lien to secure and guarantee the performance by the Corporation of any obligation or liability it may undertake.

(F) To draw, make or accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue all instruments whether is negotiable, non-negotiable, transferable, or non-transferable, including promissory maters, Bas of Exchange, Bills of Lading, Warrants and Debentures, and Bonds.

(G) To invest and deal with any money of the Corporation not immediately required of fany **F** of its objects in such manner as may from time to time be necessary.

(H) To act as Trustee (either alone or jointly with any other person or persons or corporation) of any real or personal property used or intended to be used for any religious, philanthropic, or charitable objects or purposes.

(I) To procure and obtain contributions, subscriptions, and donations of money to the funds of the Corporation or gifts devices of bequests of property of any kind for the user or purpose of the Corporation and to receive and deal with any such amounts of money or property (subject to any trusts, terms or conditions imposed by the donors thereof) for any of the objects of the Corporation as may seem expedient. (J) To effect and keep up insurance against risk, loss, or liability to which the Corporation may be subject.

(K) To pay the expenses of and incidental to the formation and incorporation of the Corporation.

(L) To employ and remunerate in such manner as may be thought expedient Corporation officers and executives, secretaries, accountants, clerks, translators, lecturers, tutors, instructors, agents, and other persons who the Corporation may consider it necessary or expedient to employ to carry on its work or otherwise in connection with any of its objects;

(M) To pay or give gratuities, pensions, or other benefits to employees and ex-employees of the Corporation or the dependents or connections of such persons.

(N) To do all such other lawful things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects hereinbefore mentioned:

#### ARTICLE VII - DISSOLUTION

If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Corporation there remains after the satisfaction of all of its debts and liabilities, any money or property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among Directors of the Corporation, but shall be given or transferred to some other institution or institutions having objects similar to the objects of the Corporation, which shall prohibit the distribution of its or their income and property among its or their Directors.
