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# AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF DOWNTOWN HOLLYWOOD PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION INC.

THE UNDERSIGNED, as Incorporator and on behalf of a not-for-profit, non-stock corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

#### ARTICLE I NAME

<u>Section 1.1</u>: The name of the corporation is DOWNTOWN HOLLYWOOD PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION INC., (the "Corporation").

#### ARTICLE II

Section 2.1. The Corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved pursuant to law.

### ARTICLE III NON-STOCK CORPORATION

Section 3.1. The Corporation shall be organized on a non-stock basis under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act and may issue Certificates of Membership.

#### ARTICLE IV

Section 4.1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the purpose for which this organization is organized is to promote the common good and general welfare of the people of the community and to primarily operate for the purpose of bringing about civic betterments and social improvements within the meaning of section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1988 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Section 4.2. The Corporation shall have the power, either directly or indirectly, either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, to do any and all lawful acts and things and to engage in any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, suitable, desirable or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering or attainment of any or all of the purposes for which a Corporation is organized. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in Section 501(c)(4) of the Code as the same now exist or as they may be thereinafter amended from time to time.

Section 4.3. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any Director or Officer of the Corporation or any other private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes); and no Director or Officer of the Corporation, or any private

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Individual, shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation.

- Section 4.4 No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate or intervens in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition of any candidate for public office.
- Section 4.5. The Corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such ilms and in such manner as not to become subject to tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
- Section 4.6. The Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
- Section 4.7. The Corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal lax laws.
- <u>Section 4.8</u>. The Corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
- Section 4.9. The Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
- Section 4.10. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not conducted or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(4).
- Section 4.11. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the essets of the Corporation, exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated for the promotion of the common good and general welfare of the people of the community, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenus Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenus Law), as the Board shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the court having proper jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of the Corporation is than located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

#### ARTICLE V MEMBERS

<u>Section 5.1.</u> This Corporation shall have a membership consisting of the Board of Directors of the Corporation serving from time to time.

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### ARTICLE VI

Section 6.1. The affairs of the Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors (heroinafter referred to as the "Board").

Section 8.2. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of the following members elected in accordance with this Section and the Bylaws and shall serve until the first election of Directors as provided in the Bylaws:


