

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S. (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be LASOTA Film Studios Booster, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

Principal street address: 501 North Davis Street Jacksonville, FL 32202

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The organization is organized and operated for the charitable purposes of supporting the student filmmakers, parents and teachers of the Cinematic Arts Program within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. This support will be accomplished by recruiting volunteers, raising funds, and hosting charitable events. Any funds received will be used to cover the cost of attending events and field trips (bus fees, participant food/lodging, tickets to events), purchasing necessary props/costumes/supplies/equipment/subscriptions for teachers to Celtx.com (screenwriting software) and motionarray.com, and classroom educational enrichment (such as approved film books, organizational equipment or storage systems.) The organization will conduct fundraising, including Movie Nights; additional types shall be determined, going forward throughout the year, to generate these funds.

The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. (All references to sections in these Articles refer to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended or to comparable sections of subsequent internal revenue laws.) In pursuance of these purposes, it shall do all things necessary, proper, and consistent with maintaining tax exempt status under section 501 (c)(3).

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

ARTICLE VIII

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any director, employee or other individual, partnership, estate, trust or corporation having a personal or private interest in the corporation. Compensation for services actually rendered and reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in attending to the affairs of this corporation shall be limited to reasonable amounts. No substantial amount of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and this corporation shall not intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles or of any Bylaws adopted thereunder, this corporation shall not take any action not permitted by the laws which then apply to this corporation.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, its assets shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or distributed to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes which shall, at the time, qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
