Pursuant to the provisions of Fla. Stat. § 617.1006, this Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be FUNDACION CARACHA TIO, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

201 Alhambra Circle, Suite 802 Coral Gables, FI 33134

<u>ARTICLE III</u> <u>PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this corporation is as follows:

- 1. Primarily, the corporation is formed exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of IRC §501(c)(3), for the promotion of the arts; namely, the diffusion and promotion of Latin American folk and popular music in the United States, especially among kids and/or other special purposes; the company may, from time to time, provide scholarships to underprivileged or low-income students with exceptional talents in music; and including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code:
- Generally, to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of Florida, or which may hereafter be conferred, including the power to contract, rent, buy, or sell personal or real property;

ARTICLE IV ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED

The Corporation shall not:

- Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation;
- 2. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three thereof;
- 3. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. And the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office;

ARTICLE V DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VI MANNER OF ELECTION

The method of election of the directors of the Corporation is as set forth in the bylaws.
