## Articles of Incorporation of

#### Lending Hand Global Foundation Inc.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: to focus on helping people in need in a variety of matters but specifically by spreading awareness of world geography. The foundation hopes to serve lowincome communities and schools with a distribution of book series called "Kobe's World Adventures", written by the founder of the organization, Kaylan Patel. All proceeds to the foundation and organization go directly to the cost of printing and distributing the books to different Tier 1 schools where more than 80% of the students are below the poverty line within the Central Florida area. The goal is to bring a piece of the world to these children who have never left, or may never have the opportunity to leave their local community. The foundation has also developed a charitable activity including Thanksgiving basket drives during November to provide food for these families in Tier 1 schools. Additionally, through this book distribution, he has also started a program called the 'Magic Carpet Reading Program'. In this program, various volunteers will go to these schools to read certain portions of the geography book to the students before they each receive their own copy of the book. This is run 100% by volunteers.

No part of the net earnings of this organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of this organization shall be the carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets remaining shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
