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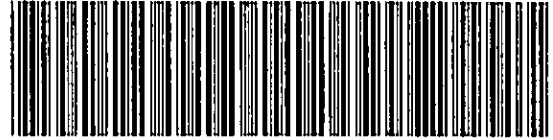

**AMENDED ARTICLES OF  
INCORPORATION**

**ARTICLE I  
NAME**

**1.01 Name**

The name of this corporation shall be The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. The business of the corporation may be conducted as The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. or Strive 4 Excellence.

**ARTICLE II  
DURATION**

**2.01 Duration**

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

**ARTICLE III  
PURPOSE**

**3.01 Purpose**

The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. The mission for which this corporation is organized is empowering youth with the life skills necessary to navigate issues facing today's youth successfully. The specific purpose of The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. shall be to promote and maintain our youth's high moral character by unlocking their potential and good mental and physical health in young people guided through the teachings of Christ. Our focus is for the children to have fun, improve general life skills, learn how to work individually and in a team, and learn how to deal with winning and losing in a positive manner that promotes good sportsmanship. These objectives

will be attained by active participation in community service, teaching well-rounded decision-making skills, reinforcing positive life skills, and preparing for the world through life experiences and educational trips.

### **3.02 Non-Profit**

The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. is designated as a non-profit corporation.

## **ARTICLE IV** **NON-PROFIT NATURE**

### **4.01 Non-profit Nature**

The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational and charitable purposes. No part of the assets, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

### **4.02 Personal Liability**

No officer or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

### **4.03 Dissolution**

Upon termination or dissolution of The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc., any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc.

In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

#### **4.04 Prohibited Distributions**

No part of the net earnings or properties of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III, Section 3.01.

#### **4.05 Restricted Activities**

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

#### **4.06 Prohibited Activities**

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (I) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (II) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

## **ARTICLE V** **BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

### **5.01 Governance**

The Charlene Dixon Youth Advancement Foundation, Inc. shall be governed by its board of directors.

## **ARTICLE VII** **AMENDMENTS**

### **7.01 Amendments**

Any amendment to the Articles of Incorporation may be adopted by approval of two-thirds (2/3) of the board of directors.
