

ARTICLE I: NAME

Section 1.01

The name of this company will be:

DYNAMIC DIVERSE SERVICES, INC.

The company shall conduct business as:

ARTICLE II: ADDRESS OF THE CORPORATION

Section 2.01 - Corporate Address



ARTICLE III: DURATION

Section 3.01

The period of duration for the company is perpetual.



ARTICLE IV: PURPOSE

Section 4.01 - Purpose

Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. (DDSI) is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding sections of any future federal tax code. The organization will engage in activities permissible under section 501(c)(3) including: conducting research, training, and educating the public on issues related to general business and marketing, career readiness, economic development, entrepreneurial training, workforce development, diversity and inclusion, and veteran issues. Our efforts will focus on providing disadvantaged individuals, businesses, and governmental entities with information, research, training, mentoring, and education to assist in economic development initiatives.

Section 4.02 - Designation

Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. is designated as a public benefit nonprofit corporation.

Section 4.03 - Collaboration

To maximize our impact on current efforts, we may seek to collaborate with other nonprofit organizations that fall under the 501 (c)(3) section of the Internal Revenue Code and are operated exclusively for educational, scientific, and charitable services within the meaning of section 501(c)(3).

ARTICLE V: NONPROFIT NATURE

Section 5.01 - Nonprofit Nature

Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. is not organized, and shall not be operated, for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational, charitable, and scientific purposes. No part of the assets, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, any individual. The corporation

may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

Section 5.02 - Personal Liability

No director, officer, or employee of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the directors, officers, or employees be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

Section 5.03 - Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc., any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of the Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonable to indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of Florida.

If the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc., then the court shall direct the distribution of Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

Section 5.04 - Prohibited Distributions

No part of the net earnings, or properties of Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc., on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, employees, or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III, Section 3.01.

Section 5.05 - Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

Section 5.06 - Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by:

- (a) a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501(c)(3)
 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or
- (b) a corporation, whose contributions are not deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal
 Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 6.01 - Governance

Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. shall be governed by its board of directors.

Section 6.02 - Election of Directors

Directors of Dynamic Diverse Services, Inc. will be elected in accordance with the procedures outlined in its bylaws.

Any amendment to the Articles of Incorporation may be adopted by approval of two-thirds vote of the board of directors.


