## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FRIENDS OF IB, INC. A FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned subscriber of these Articles of Incorporation hereby forms a non-profit corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida.

#### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be FRIENDS OF IB, INC.

#### ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business and the mailing address of the Corporation is 955 S. Florida Avenue, Bartow, Florida 33830.

#### ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specifically, the Corporation is organized to support the education of students in the International Baccalaureate program at Bartow High School by fostering relationships between the school, parents, teachers and students. In pursuance of these purposes it shall have the power to carry on any business or other activity that may be lawfully conducted by a corporation, whether or not related to the foregoing purposes, and to do all things necessary, proper, and consistent with maintain tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3).

### ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP AND MANNER OF ELECTIONS

The membership and manner in which directors are elected or appointed is as provided for in the Bylaws.

#### ARTICLE V INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is three (3) and the names and street addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial Directors until the first annual meeting, or until their successors are elected, are:

#### ARTICLE VI

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

#### ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
