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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KINGS ROAD HISTORIC DISTRICT, INC.

(A Florida Not For Profit Corporation)

I, the undersigned with other persons, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America, being desirous of forming a not for profit corporation for charitable and educational purposes under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, decay agree to the following:

ARTICLE I Corporate Name

The name of the Corporation is: Kings Road Historic District, Inc.

ARTICLE II Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address

The principal place of business of the Corporation shall be located at 204 East Moody Boulevard, Bunnell, Florida 32110. The mailing address for the Corporation shall be: Kings Road Historic District, Inc., Post Office Box 87, Bunnell, Florida 32110. Such addresses maybe changed without amending these articles.

Article III Purposes

This Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding revision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), and regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

The Corporation shall operate as a not-for-profit organization whose best interest and purpose lie in the preservation, protection, interpretation and enhancement of the Kings Road Historic District, a historic site which is located in northeast Flagler County near Pellicer Creek and Old Kings Road North, Palm Coast, Florida.

Without limiting the forgoing, the Corporation is organized to oversee the development, fundraising, construction and operation of exhibits, replica historic buildings and a museum to provide learning opportunities, events and educational programs that promote understanding of the historic significance of this region.

ARTICLE IV Duration

This Corporation shall exist perpetually from and after the date on which these Articles are filed with the Florida Department of State, unless sooner dissolved voluntarily or by law.

ARTICLE V

Management of Corporate Affairs

The powers of this Corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall be elected as set forth in the By-Laws of the Corporation. The maximum number of directors of this Corporation shall be nine (9), provided however, that such a number may be changed by a majority vote of the Board of Directors present and entitled to vote at a meeting, and further provided that there shall be no less than four (4) directors. The directors shall hold office until the first annual meeting at which time new directors will be elected.

ARTICLE VII

Registered Agent and Office

The street address of the initial registered office is Kings Road Historic District, Inc. c/o Hewitt J. Dupont, at 1515 Herbert Street, Suite 213, Port Orange, FL 32129 and the initial registered agent at such address is Hewitt J. Dupont.

ARTICLE VIII Membership

The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the power to admit members to the Corporation in such a manner, subject to such qualifications, and upon such terms and conditions as may be provided from time to time in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX

Amendment of the By-Laws

By-Laws of the Corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, or added to by a majority vote of the membership present and entitled to vote thereon at any duly called general membership meeting of the Corporation upon twenty-one (21) days notice of the proposed amendments.

ARTICLE X

Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be made by a majority vote of the membership present and entitled to vote at any duly called general membership meeting of the Corporation upon twenty-one (21) days notice of the proposed amendments.

ARTICLE XI

Dedication of Assets

The property and assets of this corporation are irrevocably dedicated to the charitable and educational purposes as set forth in Article III hereof.

ARTICLE XII

Earnings and Activities of the Corporation

- (a) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.
- (b) No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, Kings Road Historic District, Inc. shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by any organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE XIII

Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment for all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation, exclusively for the purpose of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organizations operated exclusively for charitable purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended (or the corresponding revision of any future United States

Internal Revenue Law), or to federal, state, or local governments for a public purpose, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as such Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
