ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SENIOR CIRCLE INC ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This corporation is founded exclusively for charitable religious purposes within the meaning of the IRS Code Sec 501(c)(3); namely: To establish, maintain and operate one or more Synagogues in the area of Palm Beach FL and elsewhere according to the Orthodox Jewish Law and tradition and there to provide worship services, religious instruction, spiritual guidance, religious educational, inspirational events, cultural activities, social activities and all other helpful services to the local Jewish communities and to the general communities. These will include, but not be limited to: prayer meetings, religious classes in person or online, spiritual guidance, community outreach, celebrations, sacred feasts, lifecycle events, excursions and musical praise. It will provide Jewish charity and aid to the needy.

In particular, said synagogue/s will be especially adapted to the needs of senior citizens, retirees, the aged, the infirm and their families, so that people of all ages may gather as single community in devotion to the creator of all. In its charitable activities, this corporation will seek to minister to the needs of senior populations, conducting visits to homes, hospitals assisted living homes and hospice centers and holding classes, services or inspirational events therein. It will build up the faith of seniors so they may look forward in hope and optimism.

This corporation will carry out its activities according to Torah-Halachic tradition contained in the Code of Jewish Law (Shulchan Aruch) by Rabbis Yosef Karo and Moshe Isserles and its subsequent commentaries, all as understood by this corporation's Rabbi, Yehoshua Krasnianski, who is the incorporator.

This corporation will be empowered to pay salaries or wages, as well as to rent or buy personal or real property, in order to carry out its activities and provide a residence for the Rabbi and his family. The Rabbi has been appointed according to Jewish Religious Law. He is the spiritual head of the organization and the final authority in all matters pertaining to Ethics, Spirituality and Religious Law, including the sole right to determine which questions or issues should be regarded as matters of Ethics, Spirituality and Religious Law, thus requiring his decision.

This corporation shall not, except in an insubstantial way, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of its charitable religious, purposes. It will not attempt to influence legislation in any way or participate in political campaigns of any sort. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers or any private

person except that this corporation will be empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, to work done, resources purchased or properties acquired that are seen by the directors to be in furtherance of its exempt purposes.

This corporation is empowered to supply all the foods, religious items and physical constructions or properties required according to Jewish Law and tradition, including but not limited to, Religious Articles, Kosher Food, Ritual Immersion Pools, Social halls, Dining facilities, or transportation to any event or location which in the view of the Rabbi or Directors is required for the fulfillment of Religious Duties as understood in Jewish Tradition.

Upon the filing of these articles of incorporation with the Secretary of State, the Directors will be empowered to adopt bylaws and other related documents, to appoint corporate officers and to authorize them to open bank accounts, file forms with government agencies and undertake of any other action required for the operation of this corporation. The directors will adopt such decisions through in person meetings, telephonic communication, meetings via electronic media, written and signed consent, as well as by virtual signatures. Replies sent from emails belonging to directors shall be the equivalent of written signed consent.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, the directors will --after clearing all debts and liabilities-- distribute all remaining assets to one or more organizations with similar exempt purposes recognized under section 501(c) (3) of the IRS Code.
