ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
IN COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 617, F.S. (NOT FOR PROFIT)

ARTICLE I (NAME)– Smyrna Cares Corporation

ARTICLE II (PRINCIPAL OFFICE)- 608 Faulkner St, New Smyrna Beach, FL, 32168

ARTICLE III (PURPOSE) – This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The specific purpose of Smyrna Care Corporation is to support New Smyrna Beach city employees and citizens through difficult times.

ARTICLE IV (MANNER OF ELECTION) – There will be three director positions, President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The initial directors will have a term on one year. After that term the directors can choose to reapply, or they can appoint someone else to the position. All three directors must agree on the candidate.

ARTICLE VIII (DURATION)– The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual

ARTICLE IX (OBLIGATIONS) – The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications, and obligations of members of this corporation are stated in the bylaws of this corporation

ARTICLE X (ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS) –

- The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated for charitable purposes and to specifically support families in need in New Smyrna Beach Florida. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation that is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and that has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise

provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

- No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from the federal income tax under Section 502(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contribution to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Having been named as registered agent to accept service of process of the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity.
