ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JAX SET FREE, INC. A Nonprofit Corporation

The undersigned, as the incorporator, with other persons being desirous of forming a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, forms a nonprofit corporation and agrees to the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is: JAX SET FREE, INC.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business and mailing address for this corporation is:

Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32224.

ARTICLE III

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted by this corporation, together with and in addition to the authority and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, is to be organized and shall operate exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, for the benefit of the public interest to establish, promote, assist, contribute to or otherwise encourage charitable, religious, and educational pursuits, including, for such purposes, the relief of the distressed, which includes but is not limited to the stress-related effects resulting after abortion; in connection therewith, to make distributions, awards and gifts for such purposes; and to do any such acts as are necessary or convenient to attain these purposes.

The corporation intends to qualify for an exemption from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) and qualification under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code; the corporation shall be prohibited from engaging in any activity prohibited by such sections and regulations and authority promulgated under such sections of the Code; if necessary these Articles of Incorporation shall be

amended as may be required to qualify for any such exemption or qualification. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by: (i) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (ii) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The corporation shall have all the general authority and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida subject to these Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws to be adopted to do all things necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of the above purposes and any one or more of them.

ARTICLE IV

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, of the distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III herefy No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or offerwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry or any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductive under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE V

Upon the liquidation or dissolution of this corporation, the property of this corporation then remaining after provision for liabilities shall be distributed to one or more organizations which are exempt organizations and qualified under Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the United States, State, or local government for exclusive public purposes. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VI

The name and address of the incorporator to these Articles is ANALEE KLUGE, 2468 Peg Leg Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32224.

ARTICLE VII

This corporation is to exist perpetually, and its corporate existence shall be sin on the samuary 17, 22 to 18. 2023.

ARTICLE VIII

The business of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The number of directors may be changed from time to time by the Bylaws but shall never be less than THREE nor more than TWENTY. The Board of Directors shall be elected or appointed and hold office in accordance with the Bylaws. The President of Jax Set Free, Inc. shall serve as a voting member of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IX

The initial officers of the corporation shall be President, Secretary, Treasurer and such other officers as may be provided in the Bylaws.
