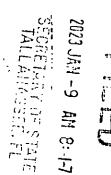

## INDELIBLE IMPACTS, INC.

(A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation)

# ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be Indelible Impacts, Inc. (hereinafter the "Corporation").

# ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND/OR MAILING ADDRESS

The street address of the initial principal office and the mailing address of the Corporation is 3800 Esplanade Way, Suite 201, Tallahassee, Florida 32311.

# ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The Corporation is a not-for-profit corporation, which is to be organized as a 501(c)(3) organization and shall be operated exclusively for charitable educational and philanthropic purposes to promote the economic and social welfare of individuals within resource-constrained communities through active and passive engagement in activities, initiatives and events held within these communities and to carry on such other activities in furtherance and support of the foregoing purposes as are lawful and proper for a corporation formed under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. Active engagement will consist of organization-sponsored health fairs, essential and non-essential resource drives and giveaways (food and toy drives), as well as participation in events that are intended to support the educational advancement of residents that make up the community. Passive engagement will consist of financial sponsorships to individuals and organizations whose purpose is determined to be in alignment with the mission of the Corporation. These passive engagements typically will not include an investment of time or labor and are intended to contribute a positive impact on the welfare of society as a whole.

# ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP

The Corporation shall have one (1) member which shall be Indelible Management Solutions, Inc., a Florida corporation, with such voting rights as are set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

# ARTICLE V INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this Corporation is at 3800 Esplanade Way, Suite 201, Tallahassee, Florida 32311, and the registered agent of this Corporation at such office is Aboye Jinkiri.

# Article IX DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this Corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to a not-for-profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, as selected by the Board of Directors.

# ARTICLE X PRIVATE FOUNDATION RULES

As the Corporation is organized so as to qualify as an organization that is a private foundation and to ensure exemption from Federal income tax under Section 509(a) of the Code, the Corporation is subject to the following restrictions:

- (a) the Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code;
- (b) the Corporation shall make distributions for each taxable year at such time and in such manner so as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code:
- (c) the Corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code;
- (d) the Corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code; and
- (e) the Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code.
