ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S. (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I, NAME

The name of the corporation shall be OPEN FRAME COLLECTIVE CORPORATION. The business of the corporation may be conducted as Open Frame Collective or Open Frame Collective Corp.

ARTICLE II, DURATION

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III, CORPORATE OFFICE

The physical address of the corporation is:

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE

4.01 Purpose

Open Frame Collective Corporation is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. Open Frame Collective Corporation's purpose is, through a collaborative approach, to promote resources and support families who have lost loved ones to overdose. In activating the Post-Recovery community (which includes those left behind after an overdose loss), our goal is to reduce the incidence and impact of drug overdose, diminish the stigma of addiction and overdose, and build the capacity for education and therefore prevention in the community. All funds whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contributed otherwise, shall be devoted to said purpose.

4.02 Public Benefit

Open Frame Collective Corporation designated as a public benefit corporation.

ARTICLE V. LIMITATIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI, OFFICERS AND/OR DIRECTORS

6.01 Governance

Open Frame Collective Corporation shall be governed by its board of directors.

6.03 Election of Board of Directors

The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed is provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

6.04 Liability of Directors

No officer or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of Open Frame Collective Corporation or any nature whatsoever, nor shall any property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII, MEMBERSHIP

Open Frame Collective Corporation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a board of directors, as defined in the corporation's bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII, AMENDMENTS

Any amendment to the Articles of Incorporation may be adopted by approval of two-thirds (%) of the board of directors.

ARTICLE IX, DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution, termination, or winding up of the Open Frame Collective Corporation, any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
