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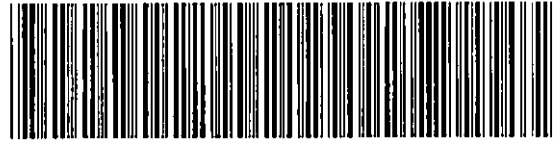

Articles of Incorporation - Addendum
Audry Organizer, Inc.

ARTICLE IX – DISSOLUTION OF THE ORGANIZATION

- a. Audry Organizer, Inc. (AO), is organized exclusively to serve families that need/require support to care for the economic, social and personal needs of seniors/elderly, disabled relatives and others in need of specific care and intervention. AO will provide social and personal care and support. AO will work to provide an opportunity for families and individuals to strengthen the lives of family members through self-sufficiency and self-help activities, workshops, seminars, training, counseling, therapy, outreach, vocational training, job placement, life skills development, and other related initiatives.
- b. Programs, services, and activities may include support from, receipt of, and the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. AO is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and social purposes.
- c. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause thereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall include the distribution of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for political office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, AO shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 107 (c) (2) of the Internal revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- d. Upon the dissolution of AO, funds shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code; or corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or shall be returned to grantors of grant funds; distributed to the federal government; or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of Miami-Dade County in which the principal office of the organization is then located; exclusively for such purposes; or to such organization or organizations; as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
