#### ARTICLE 1

The name of the corporation is:

KIWANIS OF LAUDERHILL FOUNDATION, INC.

#### ARTICLE II.

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.



#### ARTICLE III.

The purpose of the Corporation is as follows: This Corporation is a not for profit Corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this Corporation are: To improve the quality of health, education and wellness; To formulate economic and social ideas for the betterment of the human family; To operate exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organization under section 50l(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

- B. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- C. Provided, however that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code, and no part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for

services rendered and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Not withstanding any other provision of this document, the organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) an organization, contributions to which is deductible under section 1 70(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code

or corresponding section of any future tax code. The Corporation shall not be permitted to carry on any activities, except insubstantial activities, that are not in furtherance of the exempt purposes. The Corporation shall be prohibited from engaging in acts of self-dealing as described by Internal Revenue Code Section 4941 or any similar provision of any future tax code. The minimum charitable distributions as required by Internal Revenue Code Section 4942, or any similar provision of any future tax code must be made. Excess business interest may not be held in contravention of Internal Revenue Code Section 4943 or any similar provision of any future tax code. Jeopardy investments, as prohibited by Internal Revenue Code Section 4944 or any similar provision of any future tax code must not be made. Lobbying expenditures, as prohibited by Internal Revenue code Section 4945 or any similar provision of any future tax code must not be made.

#### ARTICLE IV.

The method of election of the Board of Directors shall be by the method as provided for in the Bylaws.

#### ARTICLE V.

The Officers of the Corporation shall consist of a President, Vice President, Treasurer and Trustees. Other officers may be provided for in the Bylaws. Each Officer shall be elected by the Board of Directors (and may be removed by the Directors) at such time and in such manner as may be prescribed by the by laws.
