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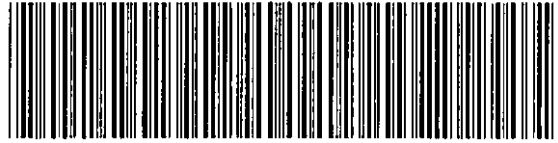

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Florida not-for-profit corporation, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

I - NAME

A. The name of the corporation is Global Development Project Kenya, Inc.

II – CORPORATE PURPOSE

A. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). It is organized pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (F. S.), with no stock issued or to be issued, in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

III. – PRINCIPAL ADDRESS

No part of the net earnings of the Religious Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Religious Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Religious Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Religious Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the Religious Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under §170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.
