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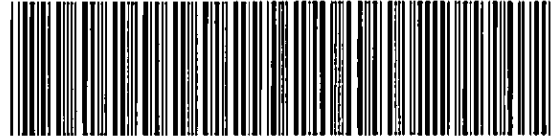



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KIWANIS CLUB OF PINE ISLAND FOUNDATION, *Inc.*

The undersigned incorporators, who are individuals 18 years of age or older, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States and pursuant to the nonprofit corporation laws of this state, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be the Kiwanis Club of Pine Island Foundation, *Inc.*

ARTICLE II. REGISTERED OFFICE

The principal office for this corporation shall be: 3280 Southshore Drive, Unit 84 C Punta Gorda, FL 33955

ARTICLE III. REGISTERED AGENT

The name and address of the registered agent is:

ARTICLE IV. DURATION

This corporation shall exist in perpetuity.

ARTICLE V. PURPOSE

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI. INITIAL DIRECTORS

The number of directors and the method of selecting them shall be fixed by the bylaws of this corporation. The initial directors are:

ARTICLE VII. INCORPORATORS

ARTICLE VIII. MEMBERS

All members, officers, directors, and trustees of the foundation shall be active members of the Club with which the foundation is associated.

The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications, and obligations of members of this corporation shall be fixed by the bylaws of this corporation.

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ARTICLE IX. COMPLIANCE WITH IRS

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE X. PRIVATE BENEFIT PROHIBITION

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

ARTICLE XI. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE XII. LIABILITY

No member, officer, or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers, or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

ARTICLE XIII. DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed by the last board of directors for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Assets can continue the club foundation's mission if transferred to the Kiwanis International Foundation/Kiwanis Children's Fund or to a Kiwanis district foundation. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated

exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE XIV. AMENDMENTS

These Articles may be amended at any meeting of the membership of the corporation at which a quorum is present by affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members present and voting, provided at least 14 days previous notice of the meeting and each proposed amendment has been given to all members of the corporation. There shall be no voting by proxy or absentee ballot. No amendments to these Articles shall be effective without the consent of Kiwanis International.


