- 2a. A description of the activity: When we meet we first go over any new Information that would be helpful to the participants at the meeting. Those that have Asperger Syndrome have a problem with socialization, so we try and add some activities that can help them. Being they are 18 years old and older, it is important for those going to college or looking for work.
- 2b. Who participates in the activity: The president, vice president, secretary and sometimes a director will be present. They will interact with the group attending, by just talking, playing board games or listening to the a guest speaker and finishing with questions and answers.
- 2c. Where you conduct the activity: We meet at LeRoy Collins Leon County Public Library, 200 West Park Avenue, Tallahassee, Florida 32301. We wanted to make it comfortable for them and we felt that the library was a safe space.
- 2d. When or how often the activity occurs: The meetings take place once a month and we would like to have occasional outings outside of our monthly meetings.
- 2e. We do not charge a fee to attend and/or join Asperger Friends. It is free for the community, whether you have Asperger Syndrome, parents, friends or an advocate. We would except donations to cover the cost of refreshments.

- 2f. Amount of the organization's overall time spent on the activity: When we have our monthly meetings at the library it is usually for 2-21/2 hours. If we should go on an outing, example would be a picnic, a hike or a local fair, it would be longer.
- 2g. Breakdown of what percentage of your resources you spend on the activity: 75% = the meeting

15% = research and obtaining a speaker

10% = maintaining the web-site

- 2h. How the activity furthers your exempt purpose: We want to be a support system to provide resources for the Asperger community. Having speakers come to talk about nutrition, how to get ready for a job interview and social skills. The need is there for communities to know and understand Aspergers. We are working on ideas for those that drive if a sticker on their car window will help tell the police that a person with Aspergers is the driver if they should get stopped.
