Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The husiness activity for said organization is as follows: to inspire, educate, and empower young girls in grades K through o who have an interest in Science. Technology Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields.
