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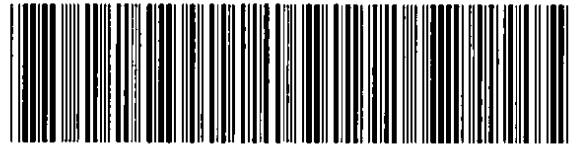

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

SCHOOL OF THE BEAUTIFUL FAR AWAY, INC.

In compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, (Not for Profit)

These Articles of Incorporation of the undersigned, all of whom are residents of the State of Florida, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I NAME

1.1 The name of this Corporation shall be:

School of the Beautiful Far Away, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE ADDRESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

3.1 This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding sections of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

4.1 The manner in which officers and directors are elected or appointed shall be described in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V NO PRIVATE BENEFIT

5.1 No part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, board of directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

5.2 Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the officers and board of directors shall be volunteers and may not receive compensation for their services as officers or directors, but may receive reimbursement for reasonable out-of-town travel expenses while acting on behalf of this Corporation's exclusively charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes work and when such travel is authorized according to the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI ADDITIONAL GOVERNMENTAL RESTRICTIONS

6.1 No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

6.2 Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII ASSETS DISTRIBUTED UPON DISSOLUTION

7.1 Upon the dissolution of this Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so

disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in Pinellas County, Florida, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VIII NO DISCRIMINATION

8.1 This Corporation's classes and school admits students of any race, color, national origin, and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students in the classes and school. This Corporation does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admission policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school-administered programs.

ARTICLE IX INDEMNIFICATION

9.1 This Corporation shall fully indemnify each incorporator, officer, and director of this Corporation, including former officers and directors, to the full extent permitted by the laws of the State of Florida. The form and content of the indemnification shall be set forth in greater detail in the bylaws, but shall never be less than the full extent permitted by the laws of the State of Florida.
