Articles of Incorporation of

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

Article I Name of the Corporation

The De'Jon L. Lee "Bumblebee" Memorial Scholarship Fund for Mental Health Studies, Inc.

Article II Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address of Corporation

Article III Corporation's Purpose

The purpose of said corporation shall be to provide financial assistance, by way of scholarship, for less fortunate students wishing to begin, or advance, their studies in the field of Mental Health. Said corporation will rely on public donations from community individuals, fundraising events, businesses, corporations, foundations, and federal and community funding opportunities, to fulfill our mission of assisting in educational opportunities, and to raise awareness of the growing problem of mental health issues among our young adults.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall

not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article IV Manner of Election

Election of new directors or election of current directors to a second term will occur as the first item of business at the annual meeting of the corporation. Directors will be elected by a majority vote of the current directors as stated in the organization's bylaws.
