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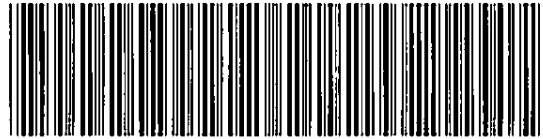

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation adopts the following amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

**Article IX**

The term of the corporation is unlimited and perpetual. In the event of dissolution, the Board of Directors/Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation to the nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operates exclusively for Christian religious purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

**Article X**

The purpose or purposes of the corporation are as follows:

A. To preach the gospel of Jesus Christ to all mankind, to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim deliverance to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are downtrodden.

B. To equip the saints of God for the work of ministry for the edifying the whole body of Christ by providing encouragement, holding regular worship services, counseling, educational materials, licensing and ordaining born again believers that exhibit the calling of God upon their lives to fulfill the fivefold ministry offices (apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers), and fulfill the vision of what God is doing globally to go to all the world by all means available with the Gospel.

C. To do all things necessary and incident to promote the general social, benevolent and charitable works of the corporation.

D. To enter into any kind of activity and to make, perform, carry out contracts of any kind in connection with, and necessary or incidental to, the accomplishment of the nonprofit purposes of the corporation. To open, maintain, and close financial accounts: checking, savings, money market and investment accounts as may be necessary to carry out the functions and financial transactions of the corporation., Timothy Wayne Parrish, President of the corporation and Chairman of The Board of

• Directors is authorized to make the final decision as to where, the type of account and with which financial institution to open said accounts of the corporation.

E. To operate exclusively for religions, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

F. To receive and administer funds, contributions for the aforesaid purpose or purposes and for no other purpose, and to that end, to take and hold by contract, agreement, devise, bequest, gift, purchase, lease, either absolutely or in trust, for such objects and without limitations, if any, as may be imposed by law; to sell, convey and dispose of any such property and deal with such property for any of the aforementioned purposes without limitation except such limitation, if any as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received; and to exercise any, all, and every power for which a nonprofit corporation under the provisions of the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Act, which can be authorized to exercise but not any other power.

#### **Article XI**

A. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its board of directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article X. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

B. Notwithstanding any of the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (A.) by an organization or corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (B.) by a corporation or organization soliciting or receiving contributions which are deductible under Section 170 (C) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code and Chapter 49 Solicitation of Contributions Act of the State of Florida Statute.

#### **Article XII**

The corporation is organized on a non-stock basis. Said corporation is to be financed by the freewill contributions to it of funds and property, absolutely or in trust.

#### **Article XIV**

A. The corporation shall have no members in the corporation.

B. In that there are no members in the corporation, the election of directors shall be by Board of Directors. The election of future board of directors shall be by the official Board of Directors requiring a two-thirds vote of the board of directors for the election of any person as a board of director of the corporation. The number of directors shall not be less than three with a maximum number as may be determined from time to time by the by-laws of the corporation and any amendment thereto. And, in the absence of the by-laws fixing the maximum number of directors, the number shall be seven. The term of the directors shall be determined by: death, resignation, and, or removal by action of the Board of Directors requiring a two-thirds majority vote of the Directors.

**Adoption of Amendments**

There are no members to vote on amendments. The aforesaid amendments listed above were adopted by the Board of Directors effective this seventeenth (17th) day of October, 2023.
