ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Not for Profit corporation shall be ENOFE & ASSOCIATES INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The addresses of the initial principal place of business shall be 5991 Chester Avenue, Suite # 204, Jacksonville, FL 32217 AND the INTERNATIONAL ADDRESS shall be No 14, 1ST Avenue, Off Christmary, Off Textile Mill Road, Evbareke Quarter, Benin City, Edo State, Nigeria. The mailing addresses are the same.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This purpose for which the corporation is organized is: to provide assistance to the less privileged both in United States and in Nigeria, to assist the elderly, widows and widowers in both the United States and in Nigeria, to assist less fortunate children in Nigeria with tuition assistance from elementary school to college, to assist the less privileged with medical and utility assistance both in the United States and in Nigeria, to assist in housing maintenance and living expenses, to provide mentorship and counseling to those in need, to foster unity and peace in the community, and to provide assistance in community development (i.e. medical supplies, hospital assistance, lighting and portable water assistance in the rural areas etc.).

This purpose shall be promoted by, but not limited to, communications through meetings, conferences, and workshops, word of mouth, radio and television advertising. Special focus shall be on those individuals and communities that that are hard to reach especially in Nigeria where people living in the villages find it difficult to have access to the basic amenities of life.

To the end that the foregoing objectives and purposes and any related to religious and charitable purposes may be carried out, performed and accomplished, this corporation shall have the power to engage only in such activities as shall not constitute business unrelated to its religious, benevolent, charitable, literary and educational purposes.

This nonprofit is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1996 or the successor provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1996 or the successor provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. Subject to the foregoing

limitations, this corporation shall have all of the rights and powers set forth in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The method or manner of the election of the board of director shall be stated in the corporate by-laws.


