ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF A FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

CORNERSTONE 386, INCORPORATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, in compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit), states as follows

Article 1 - Name

The name of the corporation shall be Cornerstone 386, Incorporated.

Article II - Principal Office

Article III - Purpose

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue

Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
