ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE HOME OWNERSHIP MADE EASY FOUNDATION, INC. (a Florida not for profit corporation)

The undersigned incorporator hereby executes these Articles of Incorporation for charitable purposes under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE 1 NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of the corporation shall be: HOME OWNERSHIP MADE EASY FOUNDATION, INC.

The initial principal and mailing address, which may be changed from time to time by action of the Board of Directors, is 200 E Granada Boulevard Suite 207, Ormond Beach, FL 32176.

ARTICLE 2 TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE 3 PURPOSES AND LIMITATIONS

The corporation is organized as a not for profit organization exclusively for purposes.

- A. The specific purposes of the corporation are:
 - benefit residents of Florida; to that end, to take and receive by gift, graded benefit residents of Florida; to that end, to take and receive by gift, graded bequest, devise or otherwise any and all property of any sort or nature, without limitation as to amount or value, and to manage, administer, invest, reinvest, and dispose of the same; to establish and administer endowment funds; from time to time pay and apply the funds and property of the corporation, including the principal as well as the income thereof, for the support of charitable works of the corporation.
 - (2) Subject to the limitations and conditions contained in any gift, devise or bequest, to invest its funds in such mortgages, bonds, debentures, shares of preferred and common stock and other securities and property as its directors shall deem advisable, and to that end to purchase, sell, mortgage, lease, pledge, encumber, assign and transfer the same.
 - (3) To the extent permitted by law, to do everything necessary or proper for the carrying out of the foregoing purposes.

- (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities which are not permitted to be carried on or conducted by organizations exempt from Federal Income tax under Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code or the regulations issued thereunder, or by organizations exempt under Section 170 (c) 2 of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- (3) Upon the dissolution of the corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively to charitable, scientific or educational organizations which then would qualify for the professors Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code and the regulations is sued thereunder, and no officer, director or private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the assets.
