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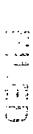

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Not for Profit Corporation under the Not for Profit Corporation Law of The State of Florida, do hereby certify:

Article I: Name

The name of the Corporation shall be

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Article II: Principal Office

Article III: Purpose

- A. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. In furtherance of its exempt purposes, the corporation may promote, establish, conduct, and maintain activities on its own behalf and it may contribute to or otherwise assist other corporations, organizations, and institutions carrying on exempt activities.
- B. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth hereof.
- C. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

E. Upon the complete or partial liquidation or dissolution of the corporation, whether voluntary or involuntary, the balance of all money and other assets, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the corporation, shall be used or distributed, subject to the order of the Circuit Court of the State of Florida, as provided by law, exclusively to one or more organizations operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

Article IV: Manner of Election

All Directors of the Corporation shall be elected as provided in the Bylaws. This Corporation shall have at least three (3) directors, who shall be appointed at the initial meeting of the corporation, in accordance with the bylaws.

Article V: Initial Officers and/or Directors

All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the affairs of the corporation shall be managed under the direction of, the Directors of the corporation. The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial trustees of the corporation are:
