Article III "Purposes"

This corporation is founded exclusively for religious and charitable purposes within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3), namely to establish or maintain one or more Churches for worship and fellowship in the spirit of independent non-denominational Christianity, and there to provide worship services, spiritual guidance, community building, religious education, fellowship meals, spiritual events, lifecycle events, celebrations and other activities. The aim of this corporation is to reach out, support, teach, preach and use God's word to uplift the homeless, the poor, the needy and the forsaken people in our community. It will inspire and educate people through sharing God's word, which is powerful and life transforming. This corporation will begin by helping people with their basic needs for food, clothing and shelter. As people's lives are changed tremendously and as their dignity is restored, they will be converted to living a godly life. They will proceed onward to become productive members of society, imbued with strong faith and belonging to a home church in which the word of God continues to be taught to strengthen and upgrade people.
