Attachment to Article III: Purpose Additional IRS Provisions

Purpose:

Our nonprofit organization, Good Seed Living, Inc., is dedicated to providing purposeful short-term, furnished rentals that are thoughtfully designed to cater to the unique needs of individuals with autism. Our mission is to offer comfortable accommodations that serve as a haven for those on the autism spectrum, facilitating vacation travel, remote working, and single-use event space while enhancing the overall vacation rental experience for everyone.

At Good Seed Living, we believe that by supporting the autistic community, we can elevate the quality of vacation rentals for the broader population. Through our strategically located properties in the vibrant short-term rental market of Florida, we aim to bridge the gap in services for the underserved autistic community while simultaneously meeting the diverse needs of all families. Our purpose is to create an inclusive and enriching environment that fosters relaxation, productivity, and memorable experiences for individuals with autism and their families, as well as for all those seeking a unique and compassionate rental experience.

IRS Provisions:

- A. This organization is a nonprofit charitable organization and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized exclusively for charitable purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles of incorporation, this organization shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this organization, and the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- C. No substantial part of the activities of this organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code, and the organization shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
- D. The property of this organization is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, members, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
- E. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this organization, shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund,

foundation or organization which is organized and operated for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(e)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
