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



Article III Purpose: The purpose of this organization includes, but is not limited to: Providing Access to Surfing: Ensuring that Dominican people, women, and youth have the opportunity to experience and participate in surfing, regardless of socioeconomic barriers. Promoting Healing: Utilizing surfing as a therapeutic tool to foster physical, mental, and emotional well-being, with a focus on Afro-Indigenous spiritual practices and connection to nature. Advancing Climate Justice: Engaging in initiatives that highlight the importance of environmental stewardship and climate resilience, educating the community on the interconnectedness of healthy ecosystems and human health. Empowering Women and Youth: Creating safe and supportive spaces where women and youth can develop skills, build confidence, and become leaders within their communities through surfing. Fostering Community Engagement: Building a strong sense of community by organizing events, workshops, and projects that bring people together to celebrate their cultural heritage and collective efforts toward environmental sustainability. Advocating for Equity: Addressing systemic inequalities by promoting inclusivity, diversity, and access to resources, ensuring that marginalized groups are represented and empowered within the surfing community and beyond.

[Purpose Section:] This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

[Distribution of Assets Section:] Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
