



Article 9: Not-for-Profit Declaration

The Inclusive AI Foundation Incorporated is a nonprofit organization and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.

Article 10: Political and Lobbying Activities

The Inclusive AI Foundation Incorporated may engage in advocacy and lobbying activities to further its mission, provided that such activities remain an insubstantial portion of the organization's overall efforts. The Foundation will comply with all applicable laws regarding such activities, ensuring they do not predominate over the Foundation's primary educational and charitable objectives.

While the Foundation adheres to regulations that restrict the carrying on of propaganda or substantial efforts to influence legislation, it is permitted to engage in limited lobbying activities. These activities are designed to advocate for issues central to its mission but will be kept within strict limits to ensure they remain an insubstantial part of the organization's operations. This includes careful monitoring to ensure that these activities do not become a predominant part of the work.

Furthermore, the Foundation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. This comprehensive restriction ensures that the Foundation remains nonpartisan and dedicated solely to its charitable and educational purposes.

Article 11: Assistance to Individuals

The Inclusive AI Foundation Incorporated is authorized to provide grants and other forms of financial assistance to individuals for purposes that align with the organization's charitable, educational, or scientific missions. This assistance will be administered through a fair and nondiscriminatory process, ensuring that it furthers the Foundation's objectives while complying with applicable laws.

Article 12: International Activities

The Inclusive AI Foundation Incorporated may conduct activities and provide grants or other assistance to individuals or organizations outside the United States. All international activities and assistance will be conducted in compliance with U.S. federal laws, including laws related to foreign funding, such as the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act and the Patriot Act. The corporation will implement procedures to ensure that all foreign activities and distributions of funds or resources are made exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes and are not diverted to any individual or organization not aligned with the corporation's mission or legal requirements.

Additional Articles

Article 13: Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of The Inclusive AI Foundation Incorporated, its remaining assets shall be distributed for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes that qualify as exempt under federal or state law, or to a federal, state, or local government to be used exclusively for public purposes. In no event shall these assets be distributed to any officer, director, or member of the corporation, or to any private individual.

Article 14: Indemnification

To the fullest extent permitted by Florida law, The Inclusive AI Foundation Incorporated shall indemnify any person who, by reason of being or having been a director, officer, employee, or agent of the corporation, or who is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee, or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise, against expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments, fines, and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by such person in connection with any threatened, pending, or completed action, suit, or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative, in which he or she may be involved, by reason of such position, provided that he or she acted in good faith and in a manner he or she reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the corporation. With respect to any criminal action or proceeding, such person must have had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful.

Article 15: Amendments

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law.
