#### **Articles of Incorporation**

#### Of

#### West Palm Beach Preservation Foundation, Inc.

We, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida relating thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

#### Article I

#### Name of Corporation

The name of the corporation is: WEST PALM BEACH PRESERVATION FOUNDATION, INC.

#### Article II

#### Purpose for Which Organized

- A. The purpose for which the corporation is organized and the requirements under which it is to be operated are as follows:
  - (1) To develop, coordinate, promote and foster educational, cultural and historical activities in West Palm Beach, Florida. In addition, to stimulate awareness, interest and support for historic preservation, heritage tourism, social history, cultural heritage, economic revitalization and restoration principles through its advocacy.
  - (2) To receive and maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property, or both, and, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for chartable, religious, scientific, literary or educational purposes, either directly or by contributions to organizations which are described in Section 501(c)(3), and are exempt from taxation under Section 501(a), of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and its regulations as they now exists or as they may hereafter be amended. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing:
    - (a) To use or apply funds on its own, or in cooperation with governmental and/or other exempt organizations, for the preservation and beautification of the City of West Palm Beach, Florida, including the acquisition and restoration of important structures in such City;
    - (b) To use or apply funds on its own, or in cooperation with governmental and/or other exempt organizations, for the acquisition of real property for the purpose of retaining such property as open or green space and/or as a refuge for wildlife where such acquisition will contribute to the wellbeing of the City of West Palm Beach.
  - (3) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall Inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no member, trustee of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.

- (4) This corporation shall not (a) devote more than an insubstantial part of its activities to attempting to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise: (b) directly or indirectly participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing or making of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office; or (c) have objectives and engage in activities which characterizes it as an "action" organization as defined in Regulations to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as they now exist or may hereafter be amended.
- (5) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, and in addition to the more specific prohibitions set forth above, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization described in Section 501(c)(3), and exempt under Section 501(a), of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or may hereafter be amended.
- (6) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, or winding up of its affairs, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively to charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
- B. As a means of accomplishing the foregoing purposes, the corporation shall have the following powers:
  - (1) To accept, acquire, receive, take, and hold by bequest, devise, grant, glft, purchase, exchange, lease, transfer, judicial order or decree, or otherwise, for any of its objects and purposes, any property, both real and personal, of whatever kind, nature or description and whatever situated.
  - (2) To sell, exchange, convey, mortgage, lease, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, any such property, both real and personal, as the objects and purposes of the corporation may require, subject to such limitations as may be prescribed by law.
  - (3) To borrow money, and, from time to time, to make, accept, endorse, execute, and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, bills of exchange, and other obligations of the corporation for moneys borrowed or in payment for property acquired or for any other purposes of the corporation, and to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed, indenture, agreement, or other instrument of trust, or by other lien upon, assignment of, or agreement in regard to all or any part of the property, rights, or privileges of the corporation wherever situated, whether now owned or hereafter to be acquired.
  - (4) To invest and reinvest its funds in such stock, common or preferred, bonds, debentures, mortgages, or in such securitles and property as its Board of Trustees shall deem advisable, subject to the limitations and conditions contained in any bequest, devise, grant, or gifts, provided such limitations conditions are not in conflict with the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
  - (5) In general, and subject to such limitations, and conditions as are or may be prescribed by law, to exercise such other powers which now are or hereafter may be conferred by law upon a corporation organized for the purposes hereinabove set

forth, or necessary or incidental to the powers conferred, or conductive to the attainment of the purposes of the corporation, subject to the further limitation and condition that, notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, only such powers shall be exercised as are in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation as may be exercised by an organization described in Section 501(c)(3), and exempt under Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended and by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of such Code and Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

#### Article III

#### Qualifications of Members and Manner of Admission

The members of the corporation shall consist of the subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation and such other person or persons as the members may elect at any annual or special meeting of the members.

#### Article IV

#### Term of Existence

This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved by law.
