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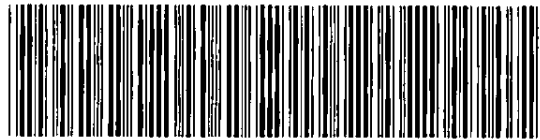



ARTICLE I: NAME, PURPOSE, AND DURATION

Section 1: The organization shall be known as CIGIR Corp. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual. RESEARCH CENTER FOR COMPREHENSIVE DISASTERS RISK REDUCTION Corp

Section 2. Fiscal Provision and Purpose:

CIGIR Corp. is established as a nonprofit organization under Section 501(C)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code, with the primary purpose of conducting applied research studies and intervention proposals to promote comprehensive disaster risk reduction and adaptation to climate change and its social, political, environmental, and technological implications. This purpose includes the development of research, projects, consultancies, programs for prospective and corrective risk management, initiatives for prevention, preparation, evaluation, mitigation, and analysis of risks and socio-natural disaster threats, humanitarian aid, conservation, and preservation of the environment and its ecosystems, combating desertification, activities related to human resources training for natural or technological disaster risk management, as well as any action that promotes awareness and action to address this global challenge.

Section 3: CIGIR Corp. is not organized nor shall it operate for the private benefit of any individual. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable, educational, scientific research purposes, and the development and execution of projects related to its nature. No part of the assets, income, or net earnings of the corporation shall be used for the benefit of, nor be distributed to, any individual. However, the corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles. We establish that no financial benefit shall be granted to individuals, and we seek to maximize collaboration with other nonprofit organizations to achieve our objectives.

ARTICLE II. MISSION:

The mission of the Research Center for Comprehensive Disasters Risk Reduction Corp., (CIGIR) is to promote understanding and the design of intervention strategies to reduce the risk of natural or technological disasters and adaptation to climate change through applied scientific research and technological development, the design and implementation of sustainable intervention projects, human resource training, educational outreach, and advocacy for evidence-based policies to mitigate the impact of disasters and adapt to the effects of climate change, environmental conservation, and human development to face the effects of disasters and climate change, and any other humanitarian aid action that may be required.

ARTICLE III. ACTIVITIES

The activities of the Research Center for Comprehensive Disasters Risk Reduction Corp., (CIGIR) may include, but are not limited to:

1. Conduct research and studies to characterize the risk of socio-natural disasters and the impact that climate change may have in different sectoral areas.
2. Organize scientific-technical events, educational campaigns, and public and private awareness campaigns to respond to disaster risk and climate change.

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The requirements and procedures to become an affiliated member shall be established by the board of directors. Two classes of affiliates are considered:

- Associated Researchers: Those who voluntarily accept to actively participate in all the programs or projects they wish to be involved in.
- Guest Researchers: Those who will only perform exclusive activities within the projects and programs executed by the corporation during the planned activities of CIGIR Corp.

ARTICLE VI: MEETINGS

Section 1. Regular Meetings:

The board of directors shall hold regular meetings called for such purposes by two members of the board of directors.

Section 2: The board of directors may convene meetings of the Technical Committee of associated researchers when necessary to address matters of general interest to CIGIR Corp.

Section 3: The minimum quorum required for the validity of all decisions of the Technical Committee of researchers' meetings shall not be less than 51% of the total number of associated researchers.

ARTICLE VII: AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS*

The bylaws of CIGIR Corp. may be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Directors or by a decision of the meeting of the Technical Committee of associated researchers, subject to any additional requirements established by applicable law.

ARTICLE VIII: DISSOLUTION

Section 1. Dissolution:

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes as set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any assets not disposed of in this manner shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX: PROHIBITED DISTRIBUTIONS, RESTRICTED ACTIVITIES, PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

Section 1: No part of the net earnings or property of this corporation, in the event of dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III, Section 3.1.

Section 2: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene (including publishing or distributing statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

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
