Attachment to Article III: Purpose Additional IRS Provisions

Purpose:

Tampa Bay Roundtable Inc offers a collaborative and supportive approach that empowers the children, families, and professionals of our community. Just as the strength of a circle relies on the collective strength of all its points, the power of our roundtable method fosters an environment where all voices are heard and valued equally, promoting meaningful discourse and actionable solutions. Our commitment is to build resilient, healthy relationships and support for positive changes that benefit the broader community. Our focus is rooted in best-practice methodologies that promote healthy and stable attachment styles and bonding. By bringing together a diverse group of stakeholders, including foster parents or caregivers, case managers, advocates, and attorneys, Tampa Bay Roundtable Inc is dedicated to enhancing understanding and reinforcing community ties, ensuring that every individual and family receives the encouragement and resources needed to succeed.

IRS Provisions:

A. This organization is a nonprofit charitable and educational organization and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles of incorporation, this organization shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this organization, and the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

C. No substantial part of the activities of this organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code, and the organization shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

D. The property of this organization is irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, members, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

E. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this organization, shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund,

foundation or organization which is organized and operated for charitable and educational purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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
