#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporation to these Articles of Incorporation is a natural person competent to contract and hereby forms a non-profit Corporation under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

#### **ARTICLE 1 - NAME**

#### 1.01 Article 1 - Name

The name of this corporation shall be **CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC.** The business of the corporation may be conducted as **CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC.** 

#### **ARTICLE II - DURATION**

#### 2.01 Duration

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

#### **ARTICLE III - PURPOSE**

#### 3.01 Purpose

**CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC.** is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for educational, religious, and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3)

of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

The purpose of the corporation is to provide Jewish religious, educational, cultural, and social services to the Jewish community and the community at large, consistent with the establishment and maintenance of a traditional Jewish community, according to Torah Halachi based on the Code of Jewish Law. and to engage in any other lawful activity as permitted by the laws of the State of Florida that shall specifically fulfill the aforementioned purposes. The following enumerated activities represent a portion but do not represent the whole of the specific activities that shall be conducted by the corporation to fulfill the intent of its general purposes:

To conduct a synagogue in accordance with the Orthodox Halachic interpretation of the Torah and Judaism;

To insure that the sacred tradition inherent in Orthodox Judaism will be maintained through the establishment of a religious school, namely Cheder Achei Temimim of South Florida;

To provide proper facilities for the dissemination of knowledge and learning to Jewish faith, history, literature and Jewish lifestyles and ideals in accordance with the Chabad Philosophy and all teachings as contained in the Torah; and

To conduct religious, educational, and social activities in connection with the observance of Jewish holidays and tradition.

#### 3.02 Non-Profit

CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC. is designated as a non-profit corporation.

#### ARTICLE IV - NON-PROFIT NATURE

#### 4.01 Non-profit Nature

**CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC.** is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part

of the net earnings of **Cheder Achel Temimim Inc.** shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC. is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational and charitable purposes. No part of the assets, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

#### 4.02 Personal Liability

No officer or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of **Cheder Achel Temimim Inc.** of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

#### 4.03 Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of the **Cheber Achei Temimim Inc.**, any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of the **CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC.** hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of the **CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC.** and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall

be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against the **Cheder Achel Temimim Inc.** by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of Florida .

In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

#### 4.04 Prohibited Distributions

No part of the net earnings or properties of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III, Section 3.01.

#### 4.05 Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

#### 4.06 Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (I) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (II) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### ARTICLE V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

#### 5.01 Governance

CHEDER ACHEI TEMIMIM INC. shall be governed by its board of directors.
