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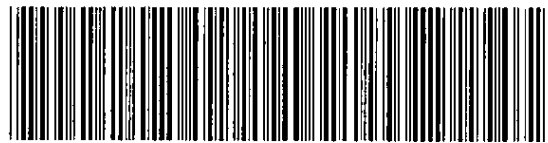

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
COURTS TO CAMPUS, INC., a Florida Not for Profit Corporation
In compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes

ARTICLE I
NAME OF THE CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation shall be COURTS TO CAMPUS, INC.

ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of the Corporation shall be located at 2851 S.W. 128 Avenue, Miami, 33175.

ARTICLE III
PURPOSE

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as tax exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The undersigned are United States citizens and desire to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. No part of the net earnings corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to the corporation's members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose(s) set forth in Article III of these Articles of Incorporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities which are not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or (b) by a corporation, contributions which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be deposited of by a court of competent jurisdiction in Miami-Dade County, Florida, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s), as the court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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Courts to Campus, Inc.'s mission is to inspire, educate, extend, promote, supervise, and develop youth in the game of basketball, while stressing the importance of integrity, sportsmanship, and fair play. The corporation shall provide training, instruction, and practice to student athletes to foster national amateur sports competition and shall promote the following goals: (a) Support and help student athletes in the program foster positive attitudes about self-esteem, sportsmanship, and team play through training and enrichment; (b) Utilizing the rigors of athletic competition to develop athletic skills and improve academic skills, while enhancing other important life skills such as self-discipline, positive relationship building, attention to details, and good sportsmanship; and (c) Compete in highly competitive basketball environments, including college exposure tournaments on a national level.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the officers and directors are elected and appointed shall be as described in the corporation's bylaws.

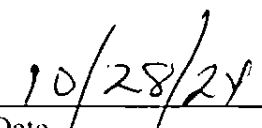
ARTICLE VIII

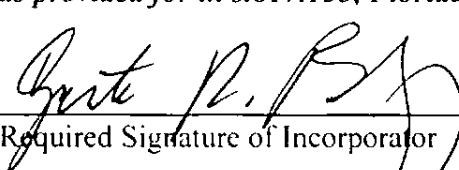

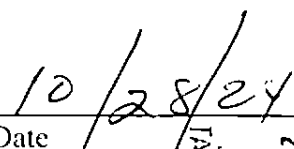
