As the newly elected Secretary of this organization I am trying to get the corporation all straightened out.

We had a new resident as secretary last year and she neglected to leave the key for the Pioneer's mailbox with someone else while she was gone on a trip to Michigan to settle her son's affairs. She had the only key to the Pioneers mailbox.

On the way up north she was involved in an automobile accident. She was able she returned home in late June. She issued her resignation, put her mobile home on the market and sold out. She turned a box of papers and the mailbox key to our President. The Treasurer who is a snowbird was in New York the president gave the mail key to the acting treasurer. The letter referred to date Jan. 28, 2003, was never seen by the acting secretary so she says. The secretary must have thrown it away, thinking it was regarding dues she knew were paid.

In July they did get a letter telling them the dues weren't paid, so the acting treasurer sent another check for \$61.25 to pay the dues and they never heard anything else. When the Treasurer came back the end of October she said she had paid the dues in January 22, 2003. She checked at the bank and the second check never was cashed by the state.

Everyone thought all was well, when I took over as Secretary in Feb 2004, I ask where is the forms from the state for the Corporation fees? No one knew. I checked with the acting-secretary who knew nothing about it. She had been checking the mailbox for a few months.

I waited awhile for the form to come, then tried to telephone the state office but the choices on the phone were not addressing my questions. I then went on-line to see if I could find out why it had not been mailed to us. It was then I found we had been dissolved.

I called our attorney he just happened to be moving his office and left a message and he sent a letter giving me a phone number to speak to a REAL LIVE PERSON which I did and he told me how to get a reinstatement form on-line and send it in with the check to cover the years dues (he also told me there was a place on the form to check without penalty) that was not on the form I downloaded.

This is a small senior park and I have told the officers that I will be the registered agent as long as I live here. So I can be sure this does not happen again and I will make sure it's all mailed on time.

We request you take all our unusual circumstances into account and waive the Fee this time if you will.
