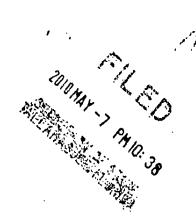

Dear Schoolhouse Theater Foundation Member,

Enclosed please find your notice and ballot for a special meeting of The Schoolhouse Theater Foundation(the "Foundation") membership to be held at The Herb Strauss Schoolhouse Theater(the "Theater") on April 30, 2010 at 10:00 am. The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss and vote on the proposal I will be describing in this letter. The Foundation's Board of Directors considered this proposal at its regular meeting on Monday, April 19,2010 and overwhelmingly voted in favor and decided to submit the proposal to members at the special meeting on April 30.

BACKGROUND TO THE PROPOSAL

In early March of this year, I met with John Boler to discuss creating a permanent endowment to support operations at the Theater. You may recall that John and Mary Jo Boler generously donated \$100,000 to the Theater last year and proudly named it after their good friend, the late Herb Strauss, who was also a great friend of the Theater. After lengthy discussions, John and I agreed that simply setting up an endowment would not adequately address the long term issues faced by the Theater. Those issues included an inadequate marketing platform, weak financial and administrative infrastructure, and less than optimal utilization of volunteer resources available on the island. We also recognized that our weaknesses were in fact strengths of another wonderful island organization, Big Arts. We concluded that joining with Big Arts would help address those issues, but only if we could ensure Big Arts' long term commitment to live theater on the island.

John proposed the following: he would donate \$1 million to the Big Arts endowment, subject to obtaining matching funds, and Big Arts agreeing to establish the Theater as an on-going Big Arts program under the direction of Art Cassell, former president of the Foundation. In addition, Big Arts would be required to segregate \$1 million of its endowment fund for the benefit of the Theater program, with annual earnings from that portion of the endowment to be used to support Theater operations. The existing Foundation would be dissolved and its assets transferred to Big Arts.

In mid-march, the Executive Committee of the Foundation's Board authorized me to engage in preliminary discussions with Big Arts regarding the proposal. Prior to those discussions, my wife Debbie and I, together with the Klug Family Foundation, agreed to match \$500,000 of the Bolers' gift, so that should the proposal be accepted, the full \$1 million would be immediately available to the Theater. John Boler and I met with Chuck Bonser, the president of Big Arts, and over a period of weeks we were able to reach agreement on the proposal, including Big Arts' written commitment to live theater on the island and Chuck Bonser's personal guarantee of his best efforts to make this combination successful. Chuck also invited me to become a member of the Big Arts Board to help ensure success of the transition, and I have agreed to do so.

YOUR VOTE ON THE PROPOSAL

If you vote "yes" on the ballot in favor of the proposal, you be voting in favor of the following to occur:

- I. John and Mary Jo Boler and Steve and Debbie Klug(together with the Klug Family Foundation) will make a conditional gift to the Big Arts endowment of \$1million. The gift will be conditional upon Big Arts continuing to operate the Theater as a live theater program on Sanibel.
- 2. Big Arts will agree to segregate the \$1 million gift for the support of the Theater program.
