ARTICLE I - NAME

(b) To solicit, accept, hold and invest, reinvest and administer funds exclusively for charitable, educational, religious purposes and to that end, to take and receive, by bequest, devise, gift or benefit of trust, and to purchase, construct upon or lease, any property, real, personal, tangible or intangible, wheresoever located and without limitation as to value.

(c) The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles the Corporation is organized exclusively for one or more the purposes specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) and shall not carry out any activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRC.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee or officer of the Corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation maybe paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation) and no member, trustee, officer of the Corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the Corporation's assets upon dissolution of the Corporation.

(d) No substantial part of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation except as otherwise provided by section 501(h) of the IRC. or participating in or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidates for public office.

(e) In the event of liquidation, dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, whether voluntary, involuntary or by operation of law, the property or other assets of the Corporation remaining after the payment, satisfaction and just discharge of liabilities or obligations, shall be distributed entirely to one or more organizations described in section 501(c)(3) of the IRC and either sections 509(a)(1) or 509(a)(2) of the IRC which are organized and operated exclusively for one or more of the purposes similar to the Corporation's purposes.

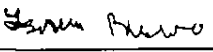

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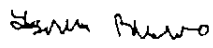
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
