ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE FLORIDA HORSEMEN'S BENEVOLENT & PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION, INC.
A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

WE, the undersigned, having capacity to contract and acting as incorporators of a corporation not for profit under the Florida Corporation Not for Profit Act, agree to organize a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, with Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is: THE FLORIDA HORSEMEN'S BENEVOLENT & PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

This is a non-profit corporation organized pursuant to the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III

The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is organized and formed are:

- (a) To promote the sport of thoroughbred horseracing.
- (b) To provide financial assistance and aid for the care, medical attention, hospitalization, funeral and burial of members and worthy former members.
- (c) To acquire, establish and maintain homes, hospitals, infirmaries or other buildings to house and shelter aged horsemen who are physically or mentally incapacitated and unable to earn a livelihood.
- (d) To institute or aid in any movement that will aid or protect the general welfare of the racing industry, the interests of horsemen and their employees, and of backstretch personnel.
- (e) To form, foster and maintain a purely charitable organization to be known as the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association Foundation, Inc., to receive and maintain funds, and to administer the same for the promotion of any of the foregoing.
- (f) To bring about a closer and more understanding relationship between horsemen, Racing Associations, Racing Commissions and the public.
- (g) To take part and advise with Racing Associations, Racing Commissions and other racing organizations in the establishment of proper rules and conditions that affect in any

manner the interests of horsemen, their employees and backstretch personnel.

(h) To represent all horsemen's interests and property rights in dealing with Racing Associations including, but not limited to:

- i. Purse monies.
- ii. Pony load fees.
- iii. Televisions rights.
- iv. Off-track betting.
- v. Interest on owners deposits in horsemen's bookkeeper accounts.
- vi. The negotiation of purse contracts.
- vii. The improvement of facilities; and,
- viii. All other matters of interest and benefit to horsemen.

(i) To promote the establishment of recreation centers at all racetracks.

(j) To work for the improvement of living conditions of member horsemen, their employees, and backstretch personnel at all racetracks.

(k) To create, establish and maintain funds to promote any of the foregoing.

(l) To purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve and use real or other personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated. To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.

(m) To perform any other act or do any other thing authorized by resolution of the Board of Directors that is not inconsistent with law or any provision of these Articles of Incorporation, and By-Laws to be created and adopted to accomplish the purposes of this association.

(n) To provide a means of disseminating information of value to its members and the community.

(o) To promote and further the mutual interests and welfare of its members.

(p) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, in no event shall any part of the earnings of this Association inure to the benefit of any individual member in his capacity as such.

(q) The corporation shall neither have nor exercise any power, nor shall it directly or indirectly engage in any activity, that would (1) prevent it from obtaining exemption from Federal Income taxation as a corporation described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (2) cause it to lose such exempt status.

(r) The corporation shall not be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade for business or profit.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; nor shall it in any manner or to any extent participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office; nor shall the corporation engage in any activities that are unlawful under applicable Federal, State or local laws.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the exempt purposes.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c), (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any further United States Internal Revenue Law) as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction in the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

As a means of accomplishing the foregoing purposes, the corporation shall have the rights and powers now or hereafter conferred upon corporations not for profit by the law of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV

There shall be seventeen (17) members of the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as Directors until the first election thereof are as follows:

ARTICLE VI

The address of the principal office of the corporation in the State of Florida shall be: c/o Calder Race Track, 21001 N.W. 27th Avenue, Opa Locka, Florida 33055, or at such other place within the State of Florida as the Board of Directors from time to time by appropriate action shall determine.

ARTICLE VIII

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended by the act of the members of the Corporation. The By-Laws of the Corporation may be made, altered or amended by the act of the members of the Corporation. Such amendment, adoption or alteration may be proposed and adopted in the manner provided in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX

The corporation shall enjoy and be subject to the benefits, privileges and immunities, restrictions, liabilities and obligations as provided for corporations not for profit organized under the provisions of the Florida Statutes 617, Part I, or such Statute as amended or modified, subject to the limitation and condition that, notwithstanding any other provision of this charter, only such power shall be exercised as are in furtherance of the tax exempt purposes of the corporation and as may be exercised by an organization exempt under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations, and by any organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of such Code or regulations.

ARTICLE X

It is the intention of the subscribers to these Articles to file for such tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code referred to above subsequent to the issuance of their charter from the State of Florida.

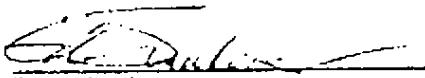
ARTICLE XII

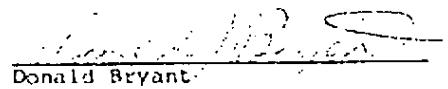

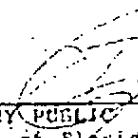

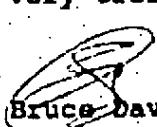
