The following are the Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation for The Sanctuary Property Owners' Association, Inc. The purpose of these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation is to continue the purposes of the original Articles of Incorporation filed on November 3, 1988, which were amended. The amendments were filed with the Secretary of State on October 2, 1997, and recorded in the public records of Martin County, Florida at Official Records Book 1378, Page 1416 et. seq.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be The Sanctuary Property Owners' Association, Inc., hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Association".

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES

The general nature, objects and purposes of the Association shall be the operation and management of the affairs and property of the residential development known as the Sanctuary located in Martin County, Florida, and to perform all acts provided in the Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions in The Sanctuary (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Covenants and Restrictions"), Bylaws, and Chapters 617 and 720, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III

GENERAL POWERS

The general powers that the Association shall have are as follows:

- A. To hold funds solely and exclusively for the benefit of its members for purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.
- B. To promulgate and enforce rules, regulations, Covenants and Restrictions, Bylaws and agreements to effectuate the purpose for which the Association is organized.
 - C. To delegate power or powers where each is deemed the interest of the Association.
- D. To purchase, lease, hold, sell, mortgage or otherwise acquire or dispose of, real or personal property, except to the extent restricted hereby; to enter into, make, perform or carry out

contracts of every kind with any person, firm, corporation, association, or other entity; to do any and all acts necessary or expedient for carrying on any and all purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, and Covenants and Restrictions.

- E. To fix, collect and enforce assessments to be levied against property to defray expenses and the cost effectuating the objects and purposes of the Association, and to create reasonable reserves for such expenditures, and to authorize its Board of Directors, in its discretion, to enter into agreements with organizations for the collection of such assessments.
- F. To charge recipients for services rendered by the Association and any user for any use of Association property when such is deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors of the Association.
- G. To pay taxes and other charges, if any, on or against property owned or accepted by the Association.
- H. In general, to have all powers conferred upon a not-for-profit corporation and homeowners association by the laws of the State of Florida, except as prohibited herein.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERS

A. The members shall consist of the lots owners in The Sanctuary, as evidenced by a duly recorded proper instrument in the Public records of Martin County. Florida. (the property comprising The Sanctuary, being described in that plat to be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court, in and for Martin County, Florida) and all lot owners shall be members of the Association. All members of the Association must be natural persons or trusts.

ARTICLE V

VOTING

A. Subject to the restrictions and limitations herein-after set forth, each member shall be entitled to one (1) vote for each lot or unit in which he holds the interest required for membership. When one or more person holds such interest or interests in any lot or unit, all such persons shall be members and the vote for each lot or unit shall be exercised as they, among themselves, determine, but in no event shall more than one (1) vote be east with respect to any lot or unit. Except where otherwise required under the provisions of these Articles, the Covenants and Restrictions or by law, the affirmative vote of the owners of a majority of lots or units represented at any member of the members duly called, and at which a quorum is present, shall be binding upon the members. If a lot or unit is owned by a trust, a designated voting certificate must be filed with the Association designating a person to vote on behalf of the entity.

ARTICLE VI

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- A. The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors elected by and from among the members. Directors must be members of the Association. If a lot or unit is owned by a trust, the trustee or beneficiary is eligible to serve on the Board of Directors.
- B. Directors shall be elected by the members and shall hold office until their successors are elected and shall qualify. Procedures and requirements for meetings and the election and replacement of directors shall be designated by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VII

OFFICERS

Offices may be held by the same person except the offices of president and secretary. Officers shall be elected for two (2) year terms in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII

CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The Association shall have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IX

BYLAWS

The Board of Directors shall adopt Bylaws of the Association, to be consistent with these Articles, and may alter, amend or rescind them in any manner provided by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE X

AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

- A. These Articles may be altered, amended or repealed by resolution of the Board of Directors.
- B. Any amendment hereto which would affect the surface water management system established for The Sanctuary, including the water management portions of the common areas, must be approved by the South Florida Water Management District.

ARTICLE XI

INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

- A. Every director and officer of the Association shall be indemnified by the Association against all expenses and liability, including attorneys fees, incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding to which he may be a party or in which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been a director of officer, whether or not he is a director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred, except in such cases where the director or officer is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance in the performance of his duties; provided however, that in the event of any claim for reimbursement or indemnification hereunder based upon a settlement by the director or officer seeking such reimbursement or indemnification, the indemnification herein shall apply only if the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being in the best interest of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such officer or director may be entitled.
- B. The foregoing rights of indemnification shall not be deemed to limit, in any way, the powers of the Association to indemnify under applicable law.

ARTICLE XII

TRANSACTION IN WHICH DIRECTORS OR OFFICERS ARE INTERESTED

- A. No contract or transaction between the Association and one or more of its directors or officers, or between the Association and any other corporation, partnership, association or other organization in which one or more of its directors or officers are directors or officers, or have a financial interest, shall be invalid, void or voidable solely for such reasons or solely because the director or officer is present or participates in the meeting of the board or committee thereof which authorized the contract or transaction, or solely because his or their votes are counted for such purpose. No director or officer of the Association shall incur liability by reason of the fact that he is or may be interested in any such contract or transaction.
- B. Interested Directors may be counted in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the Board of Directors or of a committee which authorized the contract or transaction.

ARTICLE XIII

DISSOLUTION OF THE ASSOCIATION

A. Upon dissolution of the Association, all of its assets remaining after provisions for creditors and payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed in the following manner:

- 1. By dedication to any applicable municipal or other governmental authority of any property determined by the Board of Directors of the Association to be appropriate for such dedication and which the applicable authority is willing to accept.
- 2. Remaining assets, if any, shall be distributed among the members, subject to the limitations set forth below, as tenants-in-common, each member's share of the assets to be determined in accordance with the member's voting rights.
- 3. The Association may be dissolved upon a resolution to that effect being approved by two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of the members of the Board of Directors, and in accordance with Section 617.05. Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE XIV

REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The registered office of this corporation shall be at a location designed by the Board of Directors from time to time. The registered agent shall be designated by the Board of Directors from time to time

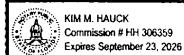
