AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION CHARLOTTE-DESOTO COLLEGE FOUNDATION, INC.

WHEREAS, since the incorporation of this Not For Profit Garage oration, the purpose for which the Corporation exists has changed; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of this Corporation deems it necessary that the Articles of Incorporation be amended to reflect such change in purpose; and,

WHEREAS, the Articles of Incorporation are silent as to the method of amending such Articles; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 617.1002, Florida Statutes, the Board of Directors of Charlotte-DeSoto College Foundation, Inc., hereby adopts the following Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation.

BE IT RESOLVED that ARTICLE THREE of the Articles of Incorporation of Charlotte-DeSoto College Foundation, Inc., is amended to be as follows:

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSES

1. The purpose of this Corporation shall be the promotion and development of educational, cultural, scientific, and charitable activities in the State of Florida and in particular the granting of scholarships to assist adults in obtaining a Bachelor's Degree. These Articles shall be liberally construed to give the fullest possible effect to such purposes, and this Corporation shall be empowered to engage in all lawful activity in the furtherance of such purpose.

2. All other provisions of the Articles of Incorporation shall remain in full force and effect.
