ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

TO

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HAMILTON COUNTY CONCERNED CITIZENS, INC.

- 1. The name of the corporation is Hamilton County Concerned Citizens, Inc.
- 2. Article XI of the Articles of Incorporation of the corporation identified in paragraph 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the remaining assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for the promotion of social welfare, primarily engaged in promoting in some way the common good and general welfare of the people of the community which is qualified as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(4) or Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law as the Board of Trustees shall determine.
